Does the PollWare mobile app store anything on my phone?

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No — nothing is stored on your personal device. Our top priority is keeping your information secure. To achieve this, the PollWare app is designed so that absolutely no data is ever saved to your phone's local storage by default.

Everything you access and interact with inside the app is housed entirely on our secure, private servers. This means that none of the following are ever downloaded or kept on your physical device:

- Group chats and messages
- Tasks and assignments
- Training materials and documents
- Personal profile information

The upcoming Documents feature

If you choose to download a document via the upcoming Documents feature, that file will be saved locally to your phone. This action is completely at your discretion, and the file can be deleted at any time via your device's local file explorer.

What this means for you

We understand that privacy is critical. Because PollWare operates strictly through our secure servers, you never have to worry about your app data being accessible on your phone's hard drive.

If your device is ever lost, inspected, or subjected to a professional audit, there will be no unexpected files, chats, or documents from PollWare to uncover on the physical device itself. Your footprint on the hardware remains completely clear.
